

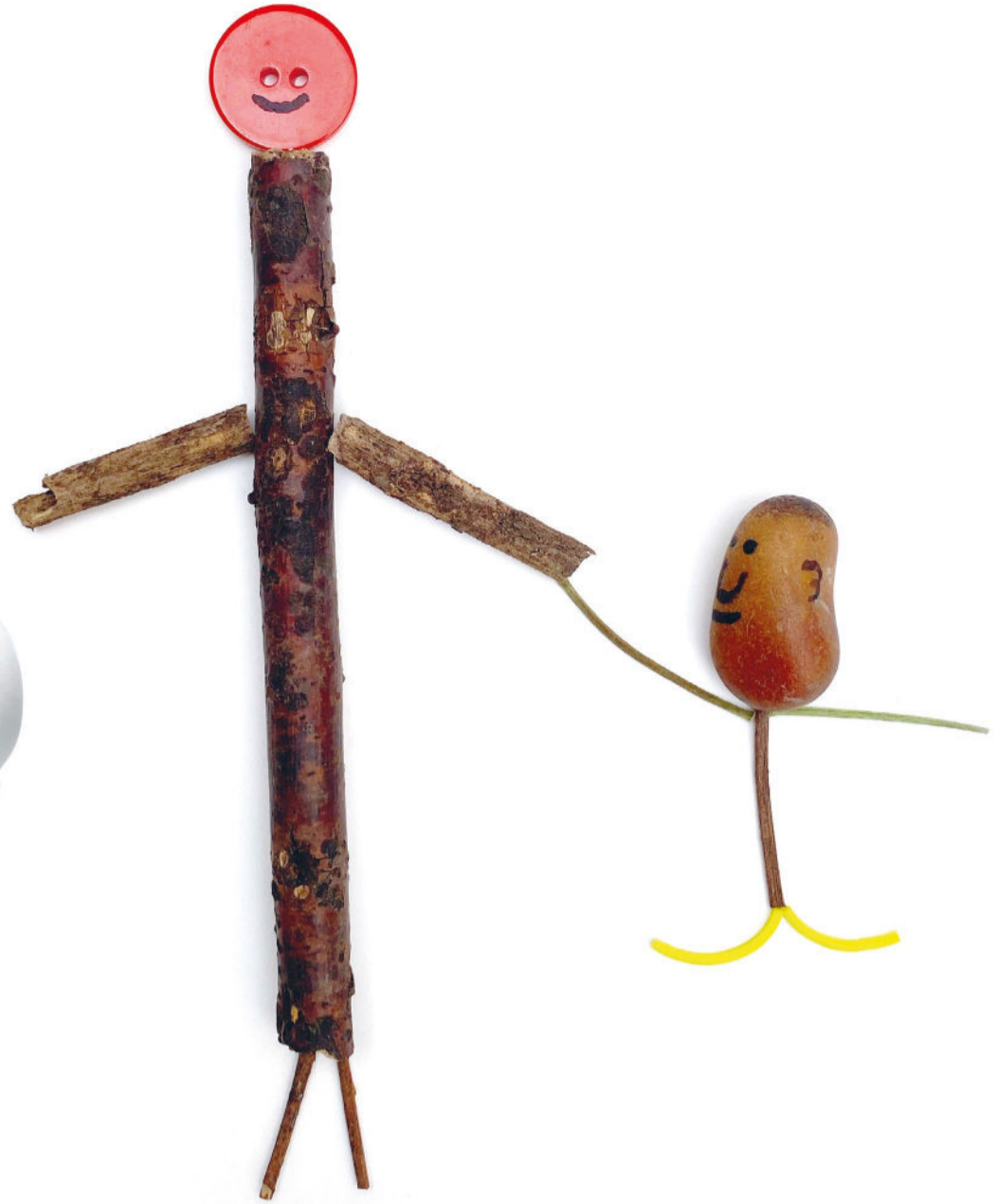


MAKE YOUR OWN CHARACTERS FROM FOUND OBJECTS

Imagine you're off to meet 3 friends in the park. Write down who you'd like to meet up with. It can be anyone, from your mum to a superhero, real or imaginary.

What words would you use to describe them? Are they soft, strong or tall? What species are they? Are they quick, quiet or scary? Are their eyes green or brown? And how many arms do they have?

Now it's time to make them out of odds and ends. Think about what you can use to show the characters. If they're loud, you could use a brightly coloured button, if they're tall, find a long stick and if they're blessed with a tail, you could use some long thread.



There is no right or wrong. Just try to have fun with forming all sorts of characters out of anything you can find!
